### Committee Reports <u>River Food Pantry</u>

The River 2017 Community Impact: In 2017 The River Food Pantry served 33,323 meals with 3.4 million pounds of food distributed to the north side of Madison and 65,946 lunches distributed to children on non-school days. Volunteers dedicated over 45,000 hours of service to keep the pantry open and running. Ninety-six cents of every dollar goes into programs and services with 55% of contributions coming from individuals.
